



## 2017 SUMMER TEAM INTERCLUB

Clubs are invited to submit entries for the 2017 Summer Interclub event being run on Wednesdays from March 1<sup>st</sup> – April 5<sup>th</sup> (6 weeks). The finishing date may change depending on entry numbers but the target for now is 6 teams per division for a round-robin plus a playoff night.

### Timetable

### Venue & Start Time

All matches will be played at the Empire Stadium, Marine Parade, Petone which will be open from 6:40pm each interclub night (**matches are due to start at 7:10pm**). Players should pay their night fees to the duty official by 7:00pm and the score sheets will be available from the control table.

### Teams

**Teams in all grades will consist of two players.**

Teams of affiliated players are to be entered by clubs (multi-club 'composite' teams are possible).

Teams with three players or four players can be submitted with any two players playing each week. In such cases it is up to the club to arrange which two players play each week.

If a team (one or both players) fails to turn up without giving 24 hours notice to the Interclub Convenor, they will be liable for the match fees of both teams in their contest for that week.

A reserve not originally named should not be of a markedly higher standard than the replaced player without prior approval of the interclub committee otherwise their matches may be awarded to the opposition.

### Format

Assuming six teams in each grade: Grades will be played as one round + final of six weeks. The format is subject to change according to entries.

Teams will play one contest each week consisting of five matches; two singles for each player and one doubles for the team. **Matches will be best of seven games to 11 points except best of 5 for the doubles.**

### Conduct

The TTW Code of Conduct will be enforced in all interclub matches.

### Ball

White 3-Star Stag balls will be provided (you must **wear non-white shirts**).

### Points

The following points system will be used in all grades: **1 point for a win; 0 points for a loss**

Matches will be recorded and used to determine placing for teams equal on points.

### Fees

All players \$7.00 each per night (i.e. **\$14 per 2-player team, per night**).

### Entry Form

The TTW Interclub subcommittee will then do the draws and endeavour to forward them to clubs by Friday February 24<sup>th</sup>. Please supply a contact email address if possible.

Table Tennis Wellington reserves the right to modify or cancel this event, depending on entries received.

A good level of sportsmanship is required at our events. In particular disrespect, intimidation, or bullying towards players, spectators and officials is not acceptable. To protect the integrity of the competition, the rights of players and officials to a safe environment, and the TTW Code of Conduct and Child Policy, the TTW interclub or executive committee reserves the right to suspend or expel a player from the competition and also to bar a player from entry into or spectating at this competition. There shall be no rights of appeal.

The above notwithstanding, the TTW Code of Conduct will be enforced and Child Policy followed. For most issues, the TTW on-duty night official (or their delegate) can resolve any disputes on the night except that matters may be raised for the TTW interclub or executive committees for consideration afterwards.

By entering, being entered, or by turning up you agree to abide by this document, the TTW Code of Conduct and the TTW Child Policy.
