



2018 SUMMER COMPETITION Two-Player teams best of 7 match format

- WHEN** Six Wednesdays March 7 – April 11
- WHERE** Empire TTC Hall, Marine Parade, Petone (04 568 6054)
- OPEN** From 6:40pm, matches to start 7pm
- FEES** \$7 per player (i.e. \$14/team) per Wednesday to the duty official before play
- ENTER** by Thursday March 1 via your club or secretary@ttwellington.org.nz (we can match extras into teams). Extra players can be named for a team but only two play for a team each evening. Teams of players from different clubs can also be entered.
- FORMAT** Two-Player teams: two singles each (7-match) + one doubles (5-match) to play in the order entered on the sheet unless mutually agreed otherwise.
- STRUCTURE** Divisions depend on entries. The aim is five weeks + a finals. Match sheets will be kept and used to determine team placings for those teams equal on points.
- RESULTS** Available <http://ttwellington.org.nz> and printed for display on the ETTC wall.
- CONDUCT** The TTW Code of Conduct (see the [website](#)) will be enforced.
- BALLS** White 3-star balls will be provided, accordingly you must wear non-white shirts.

PROVISIONS

- Players must belong to an affiliated club.
- If a team (one or both players) fails to turn up without giving 24 hours notice to the Interclub Convenor they may be liable for the match fees of both teams in their contest for that week. Rescheduling matches is possible but a last resort.
- A club can nominate reserves who may fill in for a player not ranked markedly lower.
- Table Tennis Wellington reserves the right to modify or cancel this event.
- A good level of sportsmanship is required at our events. In particular disrespect, intimidation, or bullying towards players, spectators and officials is not acceptable. To protect the integrity of the competition, the rights of players and officials to a safe environment, and the TTW Code of Conduct and Child Policy, the TTW interclub or executive committee reserves the right to suspend or expel a player from the competition and also to bar a player from entry into or spectating at this competition. There shall be no rights of appeal. The above notwithstanding, the TTW Code of Conduct will be enforced and Child Policy followed. For most issues, the TTW on-duty night official (or their delegate) can resolve any disputes on the night except that matters may be raised for the TTW interclub or executive committees for consideration afterwards. By entering, being entered, or by turning up you agree to abide by this document, the TTW Code of Conduct and the TTW Child Policy.
