## Conditions of Play

- [1] The tournament will be played under TTNZ rules.
- [2] **Plastic White 3 star 40mm balls** will be used.
- [3] TTW reserves the right to combine or cancel events.
- [4] The TTW Code of Conduct will apply.
- [5] December 31, 2018 is the criteria date for eligibility in any event. (e.g if the player turns 14 during 2019, he/she is eligible to play in the under 14 event.)
- [6] **Juniors are restricted to two consecutive age groups.**
- [7] Dress: do **not** wear clothing of a similar hue and intensity to that of the **white 3 star balls** (i.e. do **not** wear white or light coloured clothing). **All competitors must wear correct sports clothing and non marking sports shoes.**
- [8] Competitors must be available when their match is scheduled.
- [9] The Tournament Manager reserves the right to vary conditions of play.
- [10] Doubles entries will be taken at the tournament.
- [11] Games to be best of 5 sets, up to 11, advantage applying.
- [12] Consolation or plate events will be held only if time permits. There will be no plate or consolation for events played only on a round robin basis.
- [13] Some prize money will be available. For events with 4 or less entries certificates only may be awarded.
- [14] Smoking is not permitted in any part of the stadium.
- [15] Competitors must pay on arrival.
- [16] Any player arriving late may be defaulted.
- [17] No player may leave the stadium without permission from the Tournament Manager,
- [18] Previous singles winners will not be eligible for the same age group in which they were successful in previous Development Tournaments. Other experienced players may also be deemed ineligible because of tournament or interclub performances.
- [19] The canteen will be open for refreshments during the day.
