The top placed eligible player from this regional qualifier will be given a place directly to stage 2 of the TTNZ Individual Championships (Dunedin, 19th to 21st April) for the respective category(ies), Under 15, Under 19 or Open Singles. This qualifier and the qualification event in Dunedin will form part of the 2024 TTNZ National Teams selection criteria process.

PURPOSE Format of Play (Under 15, Under 19 and Open Singles Only)

Groups of 3 or 4 players with the top 2 players proceeding to knock out, with a progressive knock out from Quarter Final stage

AND

All matches are best of 5 games, with the top 4 play-offs being best of 7 games for open and best of 5 for Under 15 and Under 19

FORMAT OF If entries in an event are less than 12, then the following applies:

- **PLAY** 9-10 entries: Top 6 play progressive knock out, with all matches being best of 5 games.
  - 7-8 entries: Top 4 play progressive knock out, with all matches being best of 5
  - 6 or less entries: a full round robin with all matches being best of 5 games.

Please include "first name initial and last name" and "TTNZQ2" in the reference fields. Please note entries will not be accepted without payment and no late entries and/or payments will be accepted.

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All players submitting entries for the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted.

Players must be a member of an association affiliated with Table Tennis New Zealand (TTNZ) and meet the age and eligibility requirements set out in this prospectus.

#### **Eligible Player:**

(a) A player born in New Zealand and holds New Zealand Passport.

#### OR

(b) A player who holds a New Zealand Passport and has served their waiting period on the ITTF Eligibility Register

#### An Ineligible Player is:

- (a) A player not born in New Zealand.
- (b) A player not born in New Zealand and on the ITTF eligibility register but has not completed their waiting period.
- (c) Any player Under 13 years of age is NOT eligible for "Open" qualifier spots.

A player list must be sent to TTNZ at close of entry to confirm all players entered are eligible according to the above conditions of entry. Anyone who does not meet the above conditions of entry will be removed from the event.

#### **REGULATIONS AND TOURNAMENT REFEREE**

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis and ITTF Rules and Regulations. A national level referee will be appointed (TBC). The referee decisions are final.

Entry Closing Date - 11.59pm, 29th February

**Draw Release -** Tuesday 5th March

#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

Players may only enter one event per day. Players may enter a maximum of 2 events, being U15 and U19. or U19 and Open. A player may <u>not</u> enter U15 and Open or U19 and B grade as these events will clash. Players must be aware there may be a very demanding schedule should they choose to play 2 event categories. A player can enter Open and B Grade Singles as they are on different days.

#### WITHDRAWALS AND REFUND PROCESS

Any withdrawals after close of entry are not entitled to a refund. The only exception is due to COVID-19 related reasons, outlined in the TTNZ COVID-19 Policy, in which case a full refund for entry fees will be given. TTNZ have no responsibility for other incurred costs for the participant.

In the event of cancellation of certain events, refund is limited to the value of the applicable entry fees paid, and no additional compensation will be payable.

#### **EVENTS OFFERED**

Eligibility for age group events is determined by age as at 31st December of prior year for Under age events. Proof of age may be required.

### **SEEDINGS, DRAWS AND RESULTS**

Seedings and draws will be constructed using TTNZ player ratings at time of close of entry for each event. Seedings will be done directly from TTNZ ratings at close of entry. There will be no changes to allow for separation of association for this qualifier.

TTNZ will email the 1 eligible qualified player from the Open Men & Women, U15 & U19 boys and girls immediately after the event. The players must confirm to TTNZ within 7 days of acceptance of their qualification spot to the TTNZ Individual Event Dunedin.
